



ALABAMA LITERACY INTERVENTIONS AND SUPPORTS FOR TRANSITION (AL L.I.S.T.)

The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) is looking for LEAs who want to:

- 1. Improve transition outcomes for individuals with disabilities and their parents in planning, implementing, and evaluating project and,
- 2. Commit to actively participate in professional training for three (3) years.

**All districts selected for Cohort I will be funded \$30,000 for year one of the SPDG grant to implement transition activities.

Benefits of Participation in AL L.I.S.T

- · Development of transition team(s)
- · Support for professional development transition training for teachers, staff, administrators, and families
- · Ability to purchase materials and resources (i.e., evidence-based curriculum)
- · Support for the growth and development of school/community-based job opportunities, involvement, and experiences
- · Access to transition resources for teachers, administrators, and families
- · Greater collaboration among schools, districts, and families
- · Increased implementation capacity among teachers and leaders
- · Enhanced student-led IEPs and participation in IEP meetings
- · Partnership with Career Technical Education, Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services, and Vocational Rehabilitation Services

Requirements

- · Form a transition team to design a long-term transition district and/or school support plan
- Transition team members will represent multiple areas of transition (e.g., the business community, families, students, curriculum specialists, teachers, and site/district administration).
- · Implement an evidence-based secondary transition curriculum
- · Participate in training from state and/or national personnel
- · Commit to follow-up coaching by SPDG coaches
- \cdot Train on and implement student-focused planning and IEPs emphasizing the importance of student participation in IEP meetings
- · Inform, educate, and collaborate with students' families on the mission and goals of the program
- · Release staff from their duties to participate in training on middle and secondary transition curriculum, transition programming, transition team meetings, student-focused planning and IEPs, and SPDG-related activities, as appropriate
- \cdot Agree to participate in data and evaluation activities, as outlined by the external evaluator
- · Commit to provide sustainability funding beyond the 3rd year
